It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member before you can apply for a new permit.

An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings. There is no 6-month membership qualification time for any Morris Minor vehicle for new members.

When applying for a permit for a:

Morris Minor

Email or mail a copy of the vehicles current RWC, proof of ownership and the following **(2) VicRoads forms** 1. Club Permit Application form 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

Non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles

Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant. Members wanting to register a non-Morris Minor or motorcycle must have been a member of our Club for at least 6 months.

All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor vehicle applications must include (6) recent photos:

Motorcycle photos should include 1,2 & 5 (above) plus LHS RHS views and speedo.

Mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You **must** notify the CPS Officer (Geoff Shepherd) of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email to morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com or phone 0419 137 711. Failure to notify the CPS Officer of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

Renewals

Remember to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications. Please email or, if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with VicRoads forms. No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders. Please do not request the CPS Registrar mail your renewal and payment to VicRoads

Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

The member has ceased to be financial.

The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.

The vehicle is unroadworthy.

The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.

The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.

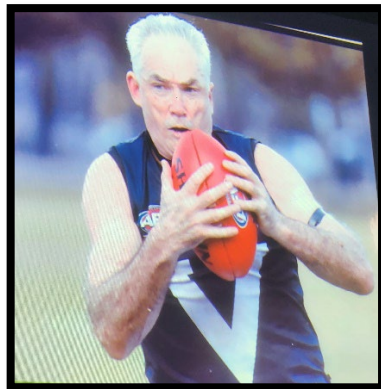
We went on to the Naked Racer, just down the road for lunch. This is a wonderful venue for lunch because it is also like a museum, housing over 250 motorcycles.

AT THE LAST CLUB MEETING:



We were incredibly fortunate to have Peter Rayson speak at the March MMCV Club Meeting. Peter told us about his history as an athlete and footy player. He described an active life up until an incident at footy camp.

In February, 2023 Peter attended a training camp organised by his club (Williamstown Superules FC) at Strath Creek some 90 km north of Melbourne. On the Saturday morning during a light training run, Peter had a heart attack and collapsed on the ground. He went into cardiac arrest. His heart stopped beating and he stopped breathing. Almost immediately a group of players and other club members started applying CPR on Peter. The venue's defibrillator was located, brought onto the ground, attached to Peter and used. After 26 minutes Peter was revived. He went on to have open heart surgery and attended Cardiac Rehabilitation. Following all of this he returned to playing football.

Peter was inspiring with his positive approach to his journey and recovery. He is very keen to spread the word about looking after your health. He went onto make a moving documentary featuring those who were involved in his resuscitation. He played this for us and it was very powerful.

His take home messages were:

1. Look after your heart – have regular heart health checks.
2. Learn Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
3. Locate the AED – defibrillator at your meeting venue.
4. Consider obtaining a portable AED for runs and club functions
5. Don't stand back if you have the chance to assist with CPR

Wheel Measurements, Hubs and Tyres

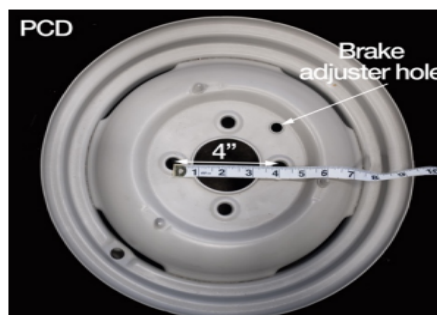
Pitch Circle Diameter (PCD)

Look at the stud pattern on the wheel. The PCD is the measurement for the distance between the centre of a stud hole to the centre of the stud hole directly opposite.

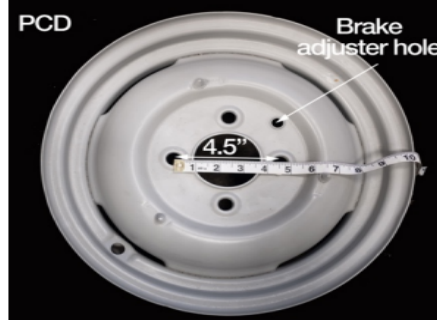
The majority of models have a PCD of 4".
(WHL103NW)
Generally 1952-53 onwards.
These have the 9" hubcap with "M" Motif.
(WHL104)
Vans after 1968 often have a Plain 9" hubcap
(WHL104A 1968-72)
No brake adjuster hole
Stud diameter smaller than earlier wheels
below. Uses 3/8 UNF nuts (SUS176) to
attach wheel to studs in hub.
Tyres - 145 X 14,
155 x 14 NB: these will not fit the spare
wheel compartment of a saloon/convertible.



Some later Series II cars have a
4" PCD with the larger 9" "M" Motif hubcap
that fit over the turrets.
This wheel has a brake adjuster hole so that
you don't need to take the wheel off when
adjusting the brakes
Uses Studs as above

155 x 14 NB: these will not fit the spare

The first cars (Series MM and some Series II –

The Series MM before car no. 131858 uses BSF wheel
bolt threads. After 131858 the MM uses wheel bolts
with 7/16 UNF threads and normally 5/8 A/F heads
which cause problems as they are too small and wear
the holes in the wheels. Also available were 7/16 UNF
bolts with 3/8 Whitworth heads (= 11/16-3/4 A/F)
which solved the problem.

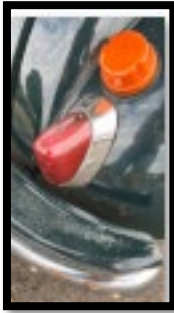

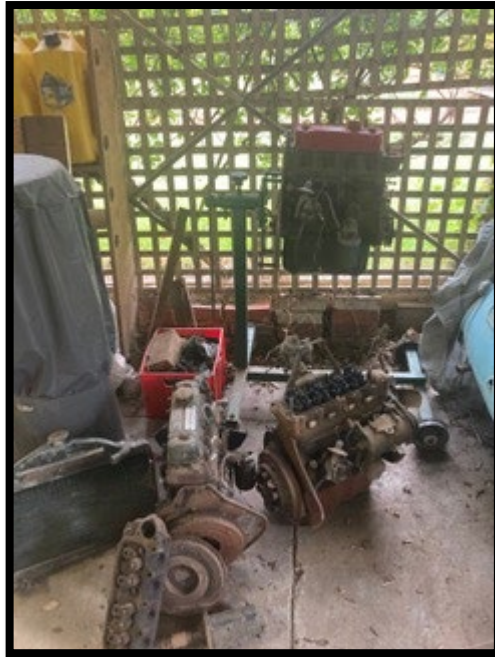
