It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

Renewals

Remember to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications. Please email or, **if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with the VicRoads Renewal form.** No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders. Please do not request the Committee to mail your renewal and payment to VicRoads.

You are always welcome to take your renewal paperwork to a monthly MMCCV meeting for an approval signature by the CPS Officer or Committee Members.

New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member before you can apply for a new permit. An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings. There is no 6-month membership qualification time for any Morris Minor vehicle for new members.

When applying for a permit for a:

Morris Minor

Email or mail a copy of the vehicles current RWC, proof of ownership and the following two **VicRoads forms** 1. Club Permit Application form 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

Non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles

Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant. Members wanting to register a **non-Morris** Minor or motorcycle must have been a member of our Club for at least 6 months.

All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor vehicle applications must include (6) recent photos:

Motorcycle photos should include 1,2 & 5 (above) plus LHS RHS views and speedo.

Mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You must notify The Committee of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email to morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com . Failure to notify the Committee of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

The member has ceased to be financial.

The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.

The vehicle is unroadworthy.

The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.

The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.

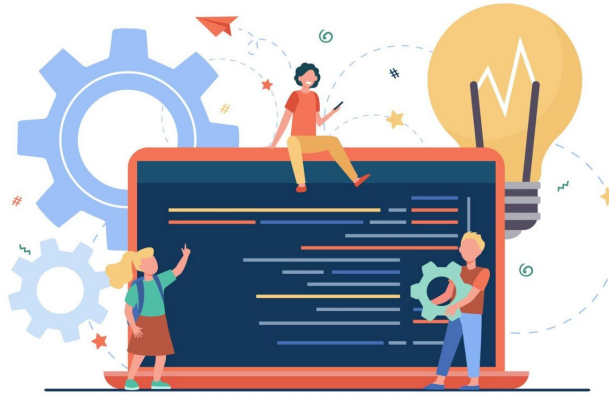

Morry Tales:

Rice Bubble's new upholstery:

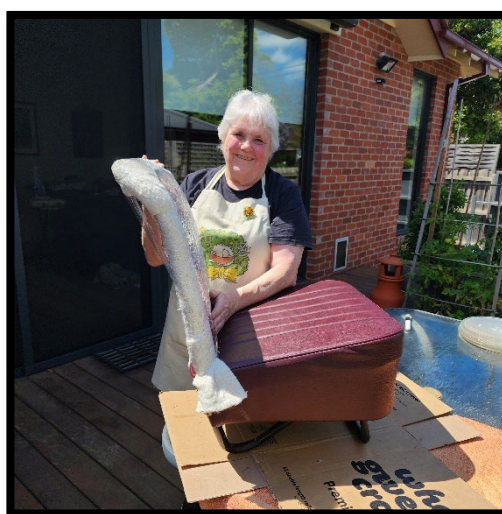
After driving to and from Morrykhana I decided that I could no longer ignore the fact that my Morry's driver's seat was just not good enough. My hips were aching and I wasn't totally certain I'd actually be able to get out of the car when I got home. So there was nothing for it.

I had ordered all the things I needed to replace the upholstery, pirelli straps; foam and squab padding early in 2023. It was time to bite the bullet. Initially, I had hoped to be able to retain the original upholstery but it was torn and unable to be salvaged.

Stripping the seat was easy, I couldn't believe how grotty the seat was so a mask and gloves were helpful pieces of kit.



Fitting the Pirelli straps was the most difficult part of the job and my husband made a very useful tool which enabled us to get the straps on.



This nifty little gadget together with vice grips allowed much easier application of the Pirelli straps.

All in all it isn't a difficult job, there are moments when you have to hold your breath because when installing new upholstery, you have to cut it. I found that the most daunting task after getting the Pirelli straps on.



I am pleased with the finish. The colour match is not perfect but it is good enough for me. I am super happy with the improved level of comfort as well as the improved vision out of the windscreen because I am sitting higher up in the car.

I will redo the padding in the passenger seat and squab in the near future but I will be able to retain the original upholstery as it is in much better condition than the driver's seat was. I have many photographs of the steps I took to get the job done, so if you are interested just let me know. There are some great YouTube demonstrations to help as well. The Florence Thomson Tour is proudly brought to you by the Association of Motoring Club (AOMC) on behalf of RACV. In February 1905, Florence Thomson was the sole female entrant in the Dunlop Reliability Motor contest from Sydney to Melbourne. Mrs Thomson was one of the 16 entrants who successfully completed the five-day trial, driving a six horsepower Wolseley, over what was then nothing more than 562 miles of dirt track between the capital cities.

To celebrate the pioneering spirit and contribution of women to Australian motoring, The Florence Thomson Tour was created as an annual event in April 2017 by the RACV.
