Interim Measures whilst CPS Officer Geoff Shepherd overseas April to End of November 2023

Note New PO BOX – This is important please.

ALL Club Permit Holders.

For new applications and renewals please mail your forms to:

“The Committee” Mail: PO Box 354 Balwyn 3103. Email during 1st of April to November 30th will be a slower response with email being checked on a weekly basis dependant on access to internet.

It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member before you can apply for a new permit.

An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings. There is no 6-month membership qualification time for any Morris Minor vehicle for new members.

When applying for a permit for a:

Morris Minor

Email or mail a copy of the vehicles current RWC, proof of ownership and the following **(2) VicRoads forms** 1. Club Permit Application form 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

Non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles

Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant. Members wanting to register a **Non-Morris** Minor or motorcycle must have been a member of our Club for at least 6 months.

All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor vehicle applications must include (6) recent photos:

Motorcycle photos should include 1,2 & 5 (above) plus LHS RHS views and speedo.

Mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You **must** notify The Committee of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email to morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com . Failure to notify the Committee of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

Renewals

Remember to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications. Please email or, **if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with VicRoads Renewal form.** No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders. Please do not request the Committee to mail your renewal and payment to VicRoads.

Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

The member has ceased to be financial.

The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.

The vehicle is unroadworthy.

The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.

The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT JUNE 2023

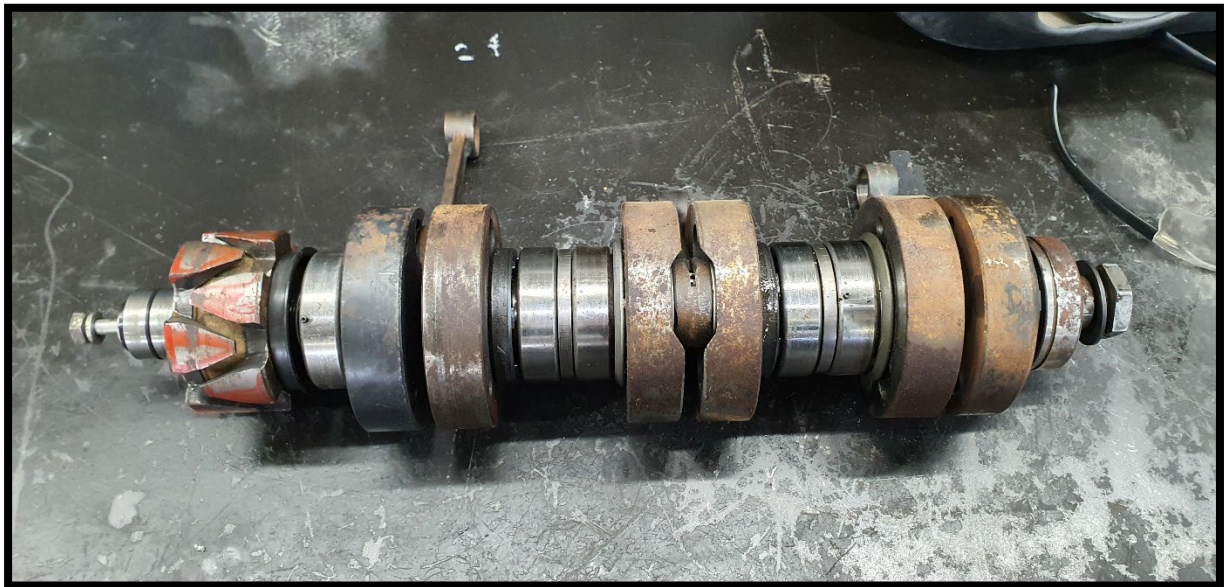


Hi Everyone,

The President welcomed the members present and online and opened the meeting at 8.04pm.

Acceptance of Minutes

Minutes of the previous meeting held 13th April 2023 accepted on the motion of Katie Hamilton and seconded by Ian Kuhne.

President's Report: As per the Generator.

Secretary's Report: Various items of information have been received by email and forwarded to appropriate office bearers. Notification received of the Benalla Historic Vehicle Tours on 26th May and the Lay Back Morrie Muster in Albury on 17th & 18th June. Some enquiries received about the sale of Morris Minors and/or parts together with technical requests. These have been referred to appropriate persons.

Club Captain's Report: While we no longer have a Club Captain, various members spoke about upcoming events. The club's run for this month is to the Werribee Mansion and is being organised by Ed James and Tim Lengyel for 21st May. Stewart is doing the run on 4th June to the Holden Museum. The Mid-Winter Run to Toolangi will be in July. The Morrykana at Roxburgh College will be held on 27th August. We need ideas for the September and October runs. Braidy suggested another visit to the Austin Healey Factory and the Spanner Man in Barraport near Boort was again suggested.

CPS Officer's Report: Nil as Geoff absent. Presently we have 107 cars on club plates.

Regalia Officers: Alan advised that he will be soon have available stubby holders and pens made with details of our club on them. Orders can be placed for club emblem badges to go on the front of cars.

The Winner of the 1950 Morris Minor Low Light Side-valve was not only a Local but is also a member of the Morris Car Club of SA.



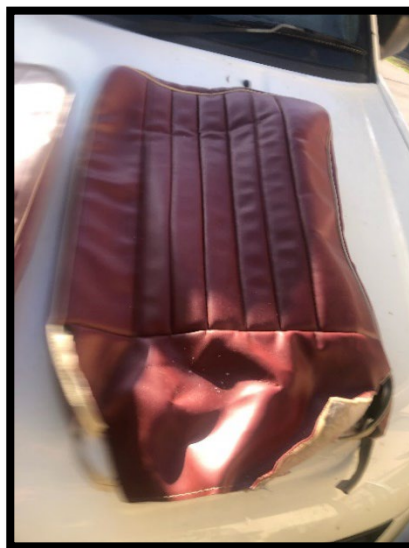
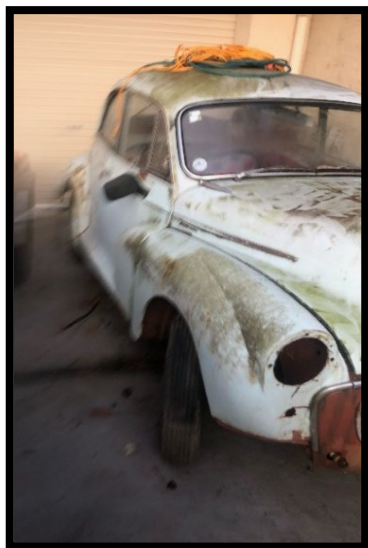
